The college is tirelessly functioning to bring the first learning generation of this hilly area into the main stream of higher education particularly from educationally, socially deprived section of the society. Our institution’s vision is “Higher Education for the Deprived Ones “We strive hard for social justice and respect all religions through intellectual, physical, cultural and emotional growth of students. The adjoining area of the college is non irrigated agriculture, hilly and tribal. The students enrolled in the college constitute most of the population of those coming from rural area. Most of the parent-farmers depend on agriculture only, and they face financial constrains in educating their wards. The students even their parents are willing to opt for higher college but inadequate finance forces them to discontinuation of education. Concession in payment of fees and waiving of fees in these cases enable the institution in fulfilling its vision of “Higher Education for the Deprived Ones”</p> <p><i>Objectives of the Practices :</i> 1.
